The Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) was created to address the environmental issues of soil erosion, water quality and wildlife habitat. The program is a financial partnership of federal, state & private dollars and offers additional incentives beyond previous federal programs.

Practices available through CREP include:

Filter strips, field windbreaks and wetland restorations. To be eligible, the land must be located within the Saginaw Bay Watershed and have crop history a minimum of four out of the six years between 2002 and 2007.
